By the third week of December, the southern region of Tamil Nadu—particularly Kanniyakumari, Thirunelvelli, Tuticorin, and Thenkasi was submerged under water, with severe consequences for the local populace. The dwellings suffered significant damage from this flood, and several of them were completely wiped away. As whole, the December turned a disaster to certain regions of Tamil Nadu.
